REGISTRATION: One coach per team is asked to register between **4:00 pm and 7:00 pm** on **Monday March 5, 2012**. Registration will occur at **Crestwood S.S.**
Registration materials will only be given to the teacher accompanying the team/athlete(s) upon receipt of the completed Eligibility List, Rules of Behaviour signature form and signed "Release of Liability" forms. These forms are on the website. Please print off and make copies as required.

EVENT LOCATION: **Peterborough Memorial Centre**, 151 Lansdowne Street, Peterborough

WEIGH-INS: **ALL WRESTLERS MUST WEIGH IN WEARING A SINGLET.**

The weigh-in will be on **Wednesday March 5, 2012** at **Crestwood S.S.**
Ten (10) scales will be available between **5:00 pm and 7:00 pm**.

COACHES/SEED MEETING: The coaches meeting will be held at **Crestwood S.S.** on **Monday March 5, 2012** between **7:00 pm and 8:00 pm**. Seeding will occur at this time.

ASSOCIATION ENTRIES: Association **ENTRY AND SEED FORMS** will be accepted from the **ASSOCIATION CONVENOR ONLY**. A separate entry form will be e-mailed to these individuals.

SEEDING: Coaches are to ensure their **ASSOCIATION ENTRY CONVENORS** submit seed information. Wrestlers falling under categories (i) (ii) (iii) (iv) (v) and (vi) **must** be seeded.

- (i) Medallist (top three) at OFSAA from previous year - if there are two equal medallists, the finalist from the higher weight class from the previous year receives the higher priority;
- (i) Canadian Junior Freestyle Medallist from previous year;
- (ii) Canadian Juvenile Freestyle Medallist from previous year;
- (iii) the fourth, fifth, and sixth place wrestlers from the previous year's OFSAA Championship;
- (iv) Provincial Junior Freestyle Medallist of current year;
- (v) Provincial Juvenile Freestyle Medallist of current year;
- (vi) best win-loss percentage (greater than 20 matches). When two (2) or more matches have been lost to any wrestler, these losses shall count as only one (1) loss - seed position can only be changed/jumped based on record if higher seed has been beaten (only using criteria (vii));
- (vii) best win-loss percentage (greater than 20 matches). When two (2) or more matches have been lost to any wrestler, these losses shall count as only one (1) loss - seed position can only be changed/jumped based on record if higher seed has been beaten (only using criteria (vii));
- (viii) the current provincial cadet open champion

ALL COSTS: Association convenors are responsible for submitting 2 cheques to cover **all** their association entries. For purposes of reimbursement the cost per wrestler is \$45.00 (\$43.00 entry fee and \$2.00 OFSAA participation fee).

UNIFORMS: **Enforced in CORRAL before athlete is allowed to proceed to the mat area.**

- a) The contestants must appear on the edge of the mat in a one-piece official school wrestling singlet. No double layers are allowed below the crotch or above the hip.
- b) Wrestlers with orthodontic devices must wear a proper mouth guard.
- c) Wrestling shoes/boots must be worn and all laces taped.
- d) All competitors are expected to dress in uniforms that are neat, clean and which maintain the integrity of the School's/Association's name, colours and/or logos. **No sport club insignia on uniforms shall be permitted.** A sport club is defined as a community, provincially or nationally based organization whose primary purpose is participation in organized competition in single or multi sport programs. Sponsorship recognition is permitted to be visible but must conform with the placement guidelines outlined in By-Law 6, Section 2(h). This criteria must be met both on and in the immediate vicinity of the competitive area and during the award ceremonies.
- e) **Student athletes must remain fully clothed in the appropriate attire in the competition area, AND use the designated locker room or change area to change to and from competition attire.** Incidents of non-compliance shall be forwarded to the Competition Committee for resolution.

EVENT APPAREL: OFSAA Wrestling 2012 **short sleeved t-shirts** (\$20.00), **long sleeved t-shirts** (\$25.00) and **hooded sweatshirts** (\$50.00) will be on sale at the competition venue throughout the tournament. (*More details to follow on the website under "Souvenirs & Apparel".*)

ELIGIBILITY: Coaches are asked to review the **Eligibility** section of the playing regulations. Wrestlers must *"meet the following age requirement: the individual's birth certificate indicates that he/she has not reached his/her 19th birthday by January 1st prior to the start of the school year in which the competition is held"*, AND *"be eligible for no more than five (5) consecutive years from date of entry into Grade 9"*.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS: Athletic trainers will be available on site. **Teams must provide their own tape.**

TEAM PHOTO: There will be a photography company on site for those interested in event photos.
